The purpose of this bill is to protect Hawaii's taro supply by appropriating funds for statewide taro research that focuses specifically on the apple snail problem.

individuals testified in support of this bill. The Department of
Agriculture, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Office of

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

No. 3425, H.D. 1, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 3425, H.D. 2.
