The purpose of this bill is to ensure equality for women and
girls in the state by appropriating additional funds to the Hawaii
State Commission on the Status of Women (Commission) for
programming, travel, and office expenses for various events
organized by the Commission.

The Commission, Kokua Council, the Oahu Chapter of Voices,
The Formerly Battered Women's Caucus, and several concerned
individuals testified in support of this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:


- (1) Changing the appropriation amount from \$53,700 to an
unspecified sum;
- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2020, to
encourage further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,
clarity, and consistency.
