Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 582  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY  
MEDICAL SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to make an appropriation for the  
establishment of a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, rapid  
response emergency medical services unit to serve the  
Mililani/Mililani Mauka area on Oahu.

The Honolulu Emergency Services Department, the  
Mililani/Waipio/Melemanu Neighborhood Board No. 25, and several  
concerned individuals testified in support of this bill. The  
Department of Health opposed this measure.


Upon further consideration, your Committee has amended this  
bill by:

- (1) Reducing the appropriation amount from \$1,900,000 to  
\$1,500,000; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for style,  
clarity, and consistency.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 582, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 582, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
