Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 137 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO MAINTAIN AND CLEAN THE KOREAN AND VIETNAM MEMORIAL ON THE GROUNDS OF THE HAWAII STATE CAPITOL,"

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Accounting and General Services and the Department of Public Safety to maintain and protect the Korean and Vietnam Memorial.
