Dr. Burrows is a graduate of the Kamehameha Schools, he received a Bachelor's degree from Linfield College, Master's degrees in education and science from Oregon State University and a Doctorate degree in education from Indiana University. He is presently a member of the Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission and is also a member of various community organizations, notably Kawai Nui Heritage Foundation, 'Ahahui Malama i ka Lokahi, and the Kailua Civic Club which are concerned with the protection and conservation of Kawainui marsh.

Your Committee notes the previous service of Dr. Burrows on the Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission and that, by law, he will only be able to serve until January 10, 2010. However, your



Committee believes that Dr. Burrows' experience and background will continue to be an asset to the Commission up to that time.
