He received his Bachelor's degree in Chemical Engineering from the University of Notre Dame. He is currently employed by Alexander and Baldwin, Inc. as its Director of Environmental Affairs. He was previously employed by Hawaiian Commercial and Sugar Company as a Environment Affairs Specialist.

Testimony in support of the nomination of Darren Strand was submitted by the Department of Agriculture, Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation, Maui County Farm Bureau, Maui Land and Pineapple Company, Inc., and one interested individual.

Mr. Strand satisfies the requirement of having a representative of the pineapple industry on the Advisory Committee on Pesticides. He received his Bachelor's degree in Biology and Chemistry from Western Oregon University. He is presently employed by Maui Pineapple Co. as its Director of Farm Operations. Mr. Strand is also a Director of the Maui County Farm Bureau.
