Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by the nominee, and finds Denny R. Sadowski to have the necessary qualifications to be nominated to the Contractors License Board for a second term.




Association. He also serves as the President of the AOA for 949 Prospect and Vice President of the AOA for Harbor View Plaza.
