Ms. Horner is a member and currently serves as President of the Hawaii Speech-Language-Hearing Association, and is a member of



She understands that the primary focus of boards and commissions is to protect the consumer and this primary focus serves as her primary reason to serve on the Board - to ensure that licensees are highly qualified.
