Your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Affordable Housing, to which was referred H.B. No. 3325, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIFORM LAND SALES PRACTICES ACT, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to streamline the registration of time share plans by exempting registered time share plans from the registration requirements of the Uniform Land Sales Practices Act, chapter 484, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Testimony in support of this measure was submitted by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs; the American Resort Development Association; Marriott International, Inc.; and Wyndham Worldwide.

Your Committee finds that registered time share plans undergo a thorough review by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs prior to commencing with sales, and, as part of the registration process, are required to prepare and keep a current, detailed disclosure document that explains the parameters of the time share plan for review by consumers prior to the purchase of a time share interest. Exempting time share plans that are duly registered under chapter 514E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, from the purview of chapter 484, Hawaii Revised Statutes, will treat registered time share plans similar to registered condominium



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projects, which are also exempt from the requirements of chapter 484, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Affordable Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 3325, H.D. 2, and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.
