Your Committees find that Myron "Pinky" Thompson was a social worker and community leader in Hawaii who made significant contributions to the Native Hawaiian community. He was a graduate of Punahou School, who earned a Bachelor's degree in Sociology from Colby College and a Master's degree in Social Work from the University of Hawaii. Mr. Thompson served as Executive Director of the Department of Social Services and Housing, Executive Director of the Queen Liliuokalani Children's Center, State Administrator under Governor John A. Burns, and as a member of the

Board of Trustees of Bishop Estate where he was instrumental in developing early childhood education programs through Kamehameha Schools.
