Due to the standing water, many roads had to be repaired afterwards. **Chicot County** Countywide 5K Flash Flood 12 1600CST Upwards to 5 inches of rain fell over the county flooding several roads. Numerous roads reported completely underwater and in need of repair. Schools were also forced to close down. **Chicot County** 1035CST 1700CST 0 0 Countywide 13 Flash Flood Additional, heavy rainfall resulted in several roads flooding once again. This aggravated ongoing flood problems **Ashley County** Countywide 13 1230CST 1700CST Flash Flood Roads reported flooded again due to another round of heavy rainfall. **Ashley County** Milo **17** Flash Flood Highway 189 near town flooded due to heavy rainfall. LOUISIANA, Northeast MorehouseParish 10K Flash Flood Countywide 12 1330CST 1700CST Extremely heavy rainfall in excess of 5 inches near Bonita flooded a church. Many roads were also flooded with some submerged under 2 feet of water. **TensasParish** 6 N Newellton 12 0.2 30 0 1K Tornado (F0) A brief tornado touchdown occurred over open country. No damage to structures was reported, but a few trees and powerlines were knocked down. MorehouseParish Countywide 13 1040CST 0 Flash Flood Periods of heavy rain resulted in widespread flooding across the parish. East CarrollParish 13 1330CST 25K Flash Flood Countywide Several roads across the parish were flooded. A few homes near a levee were also flooded. RichlandParish Countywide 13 1400CST 0 Flash Flood Several roads flooded throughout the parish, including numerous spots along highway 17 due to additional, heavy rainfall. FranklinParish

Northern portions of the parish were particularly hit hard by heavy rains and flooding. **TensasParish** Newellton 10K Thunderstorm Wind 13 0 Several trees reported down in town, with a few falling on cars and damaging them. West CarrollParish 1720CST 1830CST Flash Flood Countywide 13 0 0 Many roads were underwater. The high water also threatened a few homes. CatahoulaParish 1745CST 1930CST Countywide 13 0 0 Flash Flood Several roads across the parish were underwater. MadisonParish 1800CST 2000CST Countywide 13 0 40K Flash Flood Heavy rainfall continued through the evening hours with eight homes flooded near the city of Tallulah. **TensasParish** Countywide 13 1815CST 1930CST 5K Flash Flood Several streets in the town of Waterproof were underwater. One house was flooded with a few other homes being threatened by flood waters. MISSISSIPPI, Central **Bolivar County** 1445CST 1700CST Countywide 1K Flash Flood Many roads were flooded across the county. **Washington County** 1445CST 1630CST Countywide 1K Flash Flood Several roads were flooded, especially across northern portions of the county.. **Bolivar County** 1400CST Flash Flood Countywide 13 Flooding of roads and low-lying areas occurred, especially near the city of Cleveland. **Humphreys County** Countywide 13 1500CST Flash Flood Extensive flooding occurred county-wide due to very heavy rainfall. **Washington County** 1600CST 1830CST Flash Flood Countywide 13 Heavy rainfall caused additional flooding of several roads. **Washington County** 5 SE Greenville Abide A 13 1600CST 1915CST 0 Flash Flood

Two roads were flooded across northern portions of the county.





December 2001 Time Local/ Path Length Path Width Number of Estimated Persons Damage MISSISSIPPI, Central **Grenada County** Countywide 13 0 0 Flash Flood Several roads were inundated with water and impassable. **Leflore County** 1630CST 1930CST O Flash Flood Countywide 13 Several roads remained covered with water due to ongoing, heavy rainfall. **Leflore County** 1630CST 1900CST Countywide 13 0 Flash Flood Several roads were covered with water across the county. **Sharkey County** Countywide 13 0 Flash Flood Numerous roads were covered with upwards to a foot of water. **Carroll County** Countywide 13 1640CST 0 Flash Flood Many roads across the county were flooded due to torrential rainfall, especially in and around the city of Greenwood. **Sunflower County** 1730CST 2000CST 6 W Drew 13 Flash Flood Many roads across the northern portion of the county were inundated with water, up to a few feet deep in locales. **Warren County** Yokena 13 0 1K Thunderstorm Wind Several trees and one powerline were knocked downed across southern portions of the county. **Hinds County** 1758CST 1800CST **Pocahontas** 1K Hail(1.25) Half dollar size hail fell across northern portions of the county. Some large limbs were broken off trees. **Warren County** Countywide 1800CST Flash Flood 13 2000CST Heavy rainfall near Vicksburg, Mississippi and over northern portions of the county resulted in the flooding over several roads. **Adams County** Hail(0.75) Natchez 13 **Hinds County** 2 N Pocahontas 0.2 30 1K Tornado (F0) 13 A brief tornado touchdown was seen across far northern portion of the county. Several powerlines were knocked down along highway 49. **Madison County** 1830CST 1831CST Madison 13 0.2 25 0 1K

A brief tornado touchdown occurred west of Interstate 55 in the southwest portion of the county. Several trees were knocked down and 4 inch diameter branches snapped off. Three-quarter inch hail also occurred at this time.

Yazoo County Yazoo City 13 1K Thunderstorm Wind Trees were reported down across the city. No damage to structures reported. **Rankin County** 25 Sand Hill 13 1845CST 1846CST 0.1 1K Tornado (F0) A brief tornado touchdown was seen over open country. A few trees were knocked down. **Rankin County** 11 NE Brandon 10K 13 Thunderstorm Wind Trees were reported to be blown down on a house near Pisgah. **Holmes County** 200K Flash Flood Countywide 13 1905CST 0 Several county roads and streets were reported flooded due to heavy rainfall, especially in and around the city of Tchula where up to 33 homes and mobile homes were affected by flood waters. **Smith County** 5 E Polkville 13 1930CST 1931CST 0 1K Thunderstorm Wind Trees were downed at a community college near Center Ridge. **Newton County** Newton 0 1K Thunderstorm Wind Very large limbs were snapped off trees around town. **Neshoba County** Philadelphia 1K Thunderstorm Wind 13 Trees were knocked down by high winds in the vicinity of Westside Park. **Jones County** 5 W Laurel 13 1K Thunderstorm Wind Trees were knocked down west of town across a vast area. **Jones County** Countywide 2050CST 0 Flash Flood 13 14 0000CST Several roads across the county were flooded. **Forrest County** Hattiesburg 13 1K Thunderstorm Wind Trees were knocked down by high winds at Paul Johnson State Park. **Lamar County** 2100CST 2102CST **Purvis** 13 0 0 5K Thunderstorm Wind A house sustained roof damage from high winds. **Forrest County** 10 S Hattiesburg to 12 S Hattiesburg 1K Thunderstorm Wind

A porch roof was also blown off a mobile home.
