 A few trees were blown down on power lines.

Washington County

Arcola **09** **1900CST** **0** **0** **3K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG50)**
 A few trees and power lines were blown down.

Hinds County

4 E Bolton **09** **1908CST** **0** **0** **2K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG53)**
 A few trees were blown down at the Railroad interchange and blocked the eastbound lane of Interstate 20 for a short time.

Yazoo County

10 N Yazoo City **09** **1920CST** **0** **0** **2K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG50)**
 Several large limbs were blown down onto power lines. The top of one power pole was also sheared off.

Hinds County

3 E Raymond **09** **1954CST** **0** **0** **1K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG50)**
 A few trees were blown down along Wells road near Highway 18.

Rankin County

Florence **09** **2000CST** **0** **0** **1K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG50)**
 A few large tree limbs were blown down onto power lines.

Canton **09** **2001CST** **0** **0** **1K** **Thunderstorm Wind (EG52)**
 Strong winds blew a deputy vehicle off the road.
