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A few trees were blown down near the Yazoo county line.

A potent storm system developed across the central sections of the country and brought two rounds of severe weather to the region. The first occurred during the evening of the 17th and the second during most of the day on the 18th. Wind damage and several tornadoes occurred during this event. This mid October severe weather event was one of the top five largest across the United States.

This tornado touched down just southwest of Moorehead, in a farm field, and leveled crops before reaching Moorehead. As the tornado moved into the southwest portion of town, a number of trees were snapped, a barn had a portion of the roof blown off and a a few outbuildings were damaged. Additionally, a metal gazebo was thrown onto a house and a metal walkway was destroyed at a school.

Scattered showers and thunderstorms developed across the region and evolved into a line of storms as it moved across the area. This system did produce a little severe weather, but was mainly a rain producer and help relieve some of the drought across the area.
