The Philadelphia Water Department has produced "Cold Weather Tips," a public service announcement for TV and radio broadcast. B-roll is available also for TV newsrooms.

The video version features Philadelphia family Jim Bolno and his two sons Max, 12, and Lucas, 9, installing plastic wrap on windows and covering water pipes, as well as the water meter, with insulation to prevent their home's water system from freezing this winter.

Many homeowners are unaware that freezing temperatures and chilly winds blowing through drafty windows and doors can cause water to freeze in pipes. Freezing conditions can result in broken pipes and damaged water meters, leaving families without essential water service. Other consequences are costly plumbing repairs and damage to valuable and irreplaceable personal items stored in unheated areas, such as basements, sheds, garages, and under kitchen floors.

The Water Department recommends that customers follow these easy-to-do steps offered in "Cold Weather Tips" to keep out the cold and protect their water systems from freezing.
