5. R&R No. BOH08-01

An amendment relating to the protection of the public health through the nutrition labeling of food; amending BOH R&R 07-01, Section 1, and BOH 5.10.005, BOH R&R 07-01, Section 2, and BOH 5.10.015 and BOH R&R 07-01, Section 3, and BOH 5.10.025 and adding new sections to BOH chapter 5.10; enacted pursuant to RCW 70.05.060, including the latest amendments or revisions thereto; and declaring an emergency.

Dr. David Fleming, Director of Department of Public Health, began the discussion. Tom Bristow, King County Government Relations, briefed the Board on the actions taken by the Washington State Legislature on the issue of menu labeling.

Dr. Fleming reviewed the elements of the compromise regulation, which in part incorporates policies and procedures in the regulation; includes processes to make the regulation easier to implement and provides alternatives to labeling on menus and menu boards.

Carrie Cihak explained the effect of the regulation.
