SUBJECT: Final Fiscal Year (FY) 2006 Distribution of the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) Funding Authorized under Section 3(d) of the Smith-Lever Act after Recision

Attached is the final tabulation reflecting your institution's share of the FY 2006 formula allocation for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) after the recent 1 percent recision enacted by Congress. For the first time since the program's inception, allocations are being provided to the 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, including Tuskegee University and West Virginia State University. Since funds appropriated for EFNEP in FY 2006 exceed the FY 1995 funding level (which also is the highest level of funding for the program), 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, including Tuskegee University and West Virginia State University, are now eligible to participate in the annual funding allocations for this program. Section 883 of the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996 amended section 3(d) of the Smith-Lever Act to allow 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, including Tuskegee University and West Virginia State University, to apply for and receive funding directly for programs authorized under Smith-Lever Act section 3(d) when the funding level exceeds the highest amount made available for the program in FY 1995 or any other previous fiscal year.

These funds are made available on a quarterly basis through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Payment Management System. A Planning and Reporting page has been established on our website to assist you in locating the requirements, due dates, and submission information for EFNEP and all other formula funds. The research and extension formula programs are organized in groups: 1862 Land-Grant Institutions, 1862 Land-Grant Institutions in the U.S. Territories, and 1890 Land-Grant Institutions. Since funding continues to be contingent upon meeting fiscal and program reporting requirements, you may want to have your administrative staff bookmark the following web link for easy access to fillable forms and due dates for all formula funds:
