What DO I Do ?

Keep in Mind

1. Introductions

- Introduce officials.
- Ask students to introduce themselves.
- Ask coaches to shake hands, introduce themselves, and to sit together in back of room.

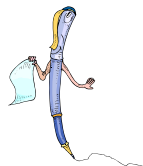


2. Rules

- Read "Important Rules" sheet at the start of each game (located in your packet).

3. Reading the Questions

- Announce whether it's a toss up or bonus question.
- Announce question category.
- Announce whether multiple choice or short answer.
- Read that question.



4. Who Won?

- Fill out official score sheet and get signatures.

Toss-Up ?

No consultation among team members.
(Shhhhhhhh)

Bonus ?

Consultation is allowed, but the captain must answer.

Challenge?

- Ask timekeeper to stop the clock

The **FIRST** answer Counts
(The **FIRST** answer always counts.)

Minimum Requirements:

- Be able to articulate clearly and maintain a good pace
- Know and be able to apply all of the rules
- A science, engineering, math, or teaching background
- Read and review the questions prior to the event
- Be at least a junior in college

Note: At the end of each match, the official score sheet should be signed and put in the corresponding round-numbered envelope. The packet should then, immediately, be taken to SBC by the Runner or official who will be going to SBC first.
