SUBJECT: CHANGE TO FILING SUPPLEMENTAL CLAIM TIMEFRAME

This letter is to inform counties of changes to the timeframes for submission of supplemental administrative expenditure claims for county child support programs resulting from the passage of Assembly Bill 1358, Chapter 808, Statutes of 2000. This bill added Section 17540 of the Family Code which requires the Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) to pay only those county claims for federal or state reimbursement which are filed with the DCSS within nine months of the end of the calendar quarter in which the costs are paid. This is a change from the prior timeframe of 18 months. The new provision became effective July 1, 2000, with the September 2000 quarterly administrative claim.

Family Code Section 17540 (a) (1)states: "Commencing July 1, 2000, the department shall pay only those county claims for federal or state reimbursement under this division which are filed with the department within nine months of the end of the calendar quarter in which the costs are paid. A claim filed after that time may only be paid if the claim falls within the exceptions set forth in federal law."
