SUBJECT: CHILD SUPPORT PROGRAM – REPAYMENT SHARING RATIOS AND NEW AID CODE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2006

This letter provides the repayment sharing ratios for the Federal Medical Assistance Percentages (FMAP) for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2006. The rates are used to determine the federal, State and county shares of child support collections on the Monthly Report of Collections and Distributions (CS 34) and the Assistance Related Distribution and/or Disbursement Summary (CS 35).

These percentages are effective October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006. The FMAP sharing ratio of 50 percent remains the same as FFY 2005.

In addition to the attached list, this letter also includes information regarding a new aid code for Medi-Cal eligible individuals pending cash aid authorization (please see All County Letter 04-22 for complete information). The new aid code and definition is as follows:

3D: CalWORKs Pending, Medi-Cal Eligible: The Department of Social Services (DSS) has instituted a new aid code following legislation that became effective July 1, 2004. Aid code 3D is used for individuals who are eligible for Medi-Cal in the month prior to the date that cash benefits become available (such as a newborn). Prior to the availability of Aid Code 3D, counties were instructed to use only aid code 3N (1931(b)). For complete information on this aid code, refer to DSS All County Letter 04-22.

Aid Code 3D meets the criteria for referral to the local child support agency. The new aid code reflects the individual's status as <u>not</u> receiving cash aid, but cash-linked Medi-Cal eligibility as the individual(s) has been determined to be otherwise eligible for CalWORKs.

Counties are <u>not</u> required to move any of the previous 3N to the new 3D aid code. Once eligible to receive cash aid, this individual will be transitioned to a CalWORKs aid code, such as 30 or 35.
