SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF MULTIPLE LIEN ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

REFERENCE: CSS Letter 06-22

The purpose of this letter is to advise local child support agencies (LCSAs) that the alternative process, described in CSS Letter 06-22 issued to LCSAs July 5, 2006, will continue until post California Child Automated Support System (CCSAS) Version 2.1 (V2.1) implementation.

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) implemented the alternative process, beginning with Statewide System Version 1.3, to aid in the appropriate processing and distribution of payments received on behalf of non-custodial parents having multiple cases with multiple real property lien enforcement actions. DCSS has determined continued use of the alternative process will be necessary as LCSAs transition to CCSAS V2.1 to ensure the consistent statewide processing of payment collections resulting from real property liens. DCSS will examine an automated solution to the alternative process for future implementation following the transition of the last LCSA converting to CCSAS V2.1.
