Alleys, Driveways and Retaining Walls

YOUR RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

Alleys, driveways and retaining walls are private property. They belong to you, the property owner; the City of Philadelphia does not own or maintain them. It is your responsibility to maintain them in a safe and sanitary condition.

All abutting owners, generally, have the right to use the entire length of an alley or driveway (this is written in your deed).

All costs for repairs or reconstruction to an alleyway or driveway are shared by those property owners having deed rights and otherwise for the use of said alleyways and driveways.

Even if only parts of an alley or driveway need repair, all responsible property owners must share the cost of the repair. For All Streets Department Services
