## **EXPANSION**:

The Adjusted Gross Revenue Lite (AGR Lite) Insurance Plan has been added to all counties **except**: 015 Chaffee, 027 Custer, 037 Eagle, 043 Fremont, 049 Grand, 057 Jackson, 065 Lake, 093 Park, 097 Pitkin, 107 Routt, 117 Summit

**DELETIONS**: None **DATES**: No Changes

## **STATEMENTS**:

A statement was added to the Special Provisions in counties where the Malting Barley Price and Ouality Endorsement is available, that provides for coverage of "sprout injury".

The statement regarding insurable malt barley varieties was replaced with a new statement that no longer requires Written Agreements.

The statement referencing "Map Area 001" was removed from the Fresh Market Sweet Corn Special Provisions.

A statement that allows for insurability of Fingerling varieties only by Written Agreement was added to all Potato Special Provisions.

A statement was added to all Sunflower Special Provisions that allows for insurability on acreage planted in rows too narrow for cultivation.

The statement providing for a shortened late planting period was removed from the Wheat Special Provisions in Rio Grande County.

The Quality provisions have been changed and Discount Factors updated on the Special Provisions for Corn, Grain Sorghum, Soybeans and Sunflowers. Quality Discount Factors have been updated on all other crops where they apply.

The Insurance Availability Statement has been revised.

TRANSITIONAL YIELDS:

T-yields for Corn and Potatoes were reviewed.

## REFERENCE RATES AND YIELDS:

Rates and Reference Yields were reviewed for Corn and Potatoes.

Certified Seed Potato option rates were increased in counties where this option is available.

Rates for Fresh Market Sweet Corn were reviewed.

The Map Area Table was removed from the FCI-35 on all Dollar Plan crops and Plan 86 crops in counties where only one map area exists. This change applies to Onions, Fresh Market Sweet Corn and Potatoes.
