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SUBJECT: St. Charles County, Missouri FCI-33 Actuarial Map

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A digitizing error with the 2007 FCI-33 Actuarial Map for St. Charles County, Missouri was recently discovered. This affects the premium rates for Corn, Grain Sorghum, and Soybeans. There are roughly 1900 acres of land classified as CCC on the 2007 FCI-33 Actuarial Map. It was intended that this acreage be classified as a lower rated area BBB.


The affected area is in St. Charles County, Missouri in Sections 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 16, & 17 –T48N-R5E. Please see the excerpts from the maps. Land in the BBB area of the CORRECTED map is the land that applies to this Actuarial Problem.




