#### **CDA SERVICES**

CDAs are one of the most valuable resources available to all facets of the Coast Guard workforce. CDA positions are located at Integrated Support Commands (ISCs), Headquarters Support Command, and Training Center Cape May. This vital position assists and advises unit Commanding Officers and officers-in-charge with organizing, preparing, and implementing a local career development program. CDAs are responsible for:

- Preparing and delivering career developing presentations to all units in their AOR.
- Reviewing and evaluating educational and/or career information materials for clarity, adequacy, and application to current workforce requirements.
- Assisting command with their efforts in helping members set personal and career goals.
- Working in partnership with Command Master Chiefs (CMC's), Collateral Duty CMCs, Rating Force Master Chiefs (RFMCs), Chiefs' Mess and Educational Services Officers (ESOs).
