## Snowpack and Water Supply Conditions for the South Platte Basin as of May 15, 2007

Since May 1, the South Platte basin has received variable precipitation. A single storm during May 5-6 delivered 0.5 to 1.0 inches of additional snow water equivalent to the snowpack along the upper reaches of the South Platte River, Bear Creek, Clear Creek and Boulder Creeks. Meanwhile, precipitation for the first half of May has been below average in the St. Vrain, Big Thompson and the Cache La Poudre basins.

That single storm event was enough to briefly boost the basinwide snowpack from 99% of average on May 4, to 113% of average on May 9. Warm temperatures since that time have allowed snowpack totals to return to 104% of average on May  $15^{\rm th}$ .

As of May 15<sup>th</sup>, only slight adjustments were made to those streamflow forecasts issued on May 1. Improvements were seen in those basins favored by the early May storm, with continued improvements to forecasts along the upper reaches of the South Platte and Bear Creek. For the most part, forecasts around the remaining basins remain relatively unchanged from May 1.

Forecasts call for near average to slightly above average spring and summer volumes throughout most of the South Platte basin. The only exceptions are the Big Thompson and Cache La Poudre Rivers, which are expected to produce volumes ranging from 75% to 85% of average.
