


The Electronic Records Archives System

- NARA's strategic investment to
 - Preserve and provide sustained access to electronic records of the U.S. Government
 - Re-engineer and automate the lifecycle management of all records of the U.S.
 Government
- A *major* system development
 - Over \$130,000,000 funding to date
 - Constant oversight by OMB, GAO, Congress




The Lifecycle of Records






Lifecycle Management of Records



Incremental Development

- Increment 1
 - Workflow for records scheduling and transfers
 - Transfers of electronic records, ingest, archival storage
- Increment 2
 - Workflow for processing presidential records
 - Content search of electronic records
 - Review of electronic records
 - Classified electronic records
- Increment 3
 - Public access to descriptions of all records
 - Access to electronic records
 - Electronic records preservation
- Increment 4
 - Expansion of capacity and enhanced functionality
 - Redaction of electronic records
- Increment 5
 - Expansion of capacity and enhanced functionality
