On May 1, 2003, the NRC completed an inspection at your Duane Arnold Energy Center. The enclosed report documents the inspection findings which were discussed on May 1, 2003, with you and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to safety and compliance with an Order issued on February 25, 2002, which required your site to implement specific measures related to the security of your facility. The inspection utilized Temporary Instruction 2515/148, "Inspection of Nuclear Reactor Safeguards Interim Compensatory Measures," to verify implementation of the Order as clarified in your responses dated March 18, 2002, and June 11, 2002. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

On the basis of the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

IR 0500050-331-03-07(DRS); IES Utilities, Inc.; on 4/28-5/1/2003, Duane Arnold Energy Center. TI 2515/148, Verification of Compliance with Interim Compensatory Measures Order.

The inspection was conducted by three regional physical security inspectors and one regional emergency preparedness inspector.

Cornerstone: Physical Security and Emergency Preparedness

- On February 25, 2002, the NRC imposed by Order, Interim Compensatory Measures to enhance physical security. The inspectors determined that the licensee appropriately incorporated the Interim Compensatory Measures into the site protective strategy and access authorization program; developed and implemented relevant procedures; ensured that the emergency plan could be implemented; and established and effectively coordinated interface agreements with offsite organizations.
- The inspectors identified an unresolved item related to duties of personnel required by Item B.4.e of the Order. This item remains open pending review of the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (Section III.A.2).
