Additional Points from Dr. Stan Piotroski, ECS

- ECS will pay for ongoing physical therapy and speech therapy. They will pay for academics and in-school devices that are needed.
- Typically, parents pay up front cost and then get reimbursed.
- It is misleading to look at the list of where special needs children are because each child is unique. One child may or may not benefit from different resources at different posts.
- It is recommended to contact ECS one year in advance about posts.
- Six months before the bid list comes out, one can try to find out what the list will probably look like.
- One may be able to informally apply at schools to see if the child will/can be accepted.
