Information for filling out the Request for international applications containing a sequence listing and/or related tables filed in the RO/US via EFS-Web

The Legal Framework for EFS-Web (http://www.uspto.gov/ebc/portal/efs/legal.htm) contains information for the filing of international applications containing a sequence listing (SL) and/or related tables in parts XVIII through XXI.

Part XIX. A. indicates that the SL part of the description should be submitted as a single ASCII text file with a ".txt" extension (e.g. "seqlist.txt"). Submission of the SL part in PDF format is not recommended because applicant would still be required to supply a copy of the SL in text format in accordance with AI Annex C, ¶ 39 for search purposes. If the SL part is submitted as a text file, applicant need not submit any additional copies. No statement is required that the SL part of the application is identical to the copy provided for search purposes when only one text file is provided.

Part XIX. B. indicates that tables related to a SL maybe be either interspersed with the rest of the description or consolidated into a separate part of the description. Description pages containing interspersed tables must be submitted in PDF format. Tables consolidated into a separate part of the description may be submitted in either PDF or text format, although text format is preferred.

Unfortunately, neither the conventional Request (PCT/RO/101) nor the PCT-SAFE/EASY Request has been modified to date to allow proper identification of the items provided in an international application containing a SL and/or related tables filed in the RO/US via EFS-Web. The following examples illustrate a means by which the Request can be filled out until it is revised.

Similarly, the Fee Calculation Sheet has also not been updated, and consequently, indication of the applicable fee for a SL and/or related tables provided in an electronically filed international application is difficult. An understanding of the three different methods for the assessment of these international fees is necessary to understand the suggested interim means to fill out the Request and Fee Calculation Sheet for international applications electronically filed via EFS-Web. Currently, there are three different methods to assess international fees for a SL and/or related tables depending upon how the international application itself and the SL and/or related tables were filed:

1) International application and SL/tables provided in paper – SL/tables are assessed per sheet, with no upper limit;

- 2) International application provided in paper with SL/tables on CD under AI Part 8, §801 SL/tables are assessed at a flat rate of 400 x fee per sheet;
- 3) International application and SL/tables provided electronically via EFS-Web (AI Part 7) SL/tables are assessed per sheet¹ up to a 400 sheet maximum.

Therefore, it is recommended that, for an international application filed electronically via EFS-Web containing a SL and/or related tables that are consolidated into a separate part of the description, together totaling less than 400 sheets (1,197,000 bytes or less), the Request be filled out as though the SL and related tables were provided in paper. Further, it is recommended that, for an international application filed electronically via EFS-Web containing a SL and/or related tables that are consolidated into a separate part of the description, together totaling 400 or more sheets (more than 1,197,000 bytes), the Request be filled out as though the SL and/or related tables were provided under AI §801. The following examples illustrate means by which either version of the Request can be filled out at the present time.
