

The King County Industrial Waste Program's EnvirOvation Award Process

Companies/organizations may nominate their own business or one or more facilities in the King County Industrial Waste Program's (KCIW's) service area. Nominees should have achieved any of the criteria/goals (below) during a given calendar year.

Companies/organizations should submit a detailed letter (limited to three pages) describing the facility's achievements during that calendar year by December 15.

KCIW staff will review all nominations.

KCIW's EnvirOvation Award is given to facilities that have achieved one or more of the following:

- voluntarily implemented an innovative pollution prevention strategy,
- significantly updated their pretreatment equipment or methods,
- significantly reduced the amount of wastes being discharged to King County sewers,
- significantly reduced their water use,
- shown leadership in helping other companies comply with industrial pretreatment regulations.

Winners are announced in the spring of each year. EnvirOvation award winners are eligible for nomination for a King County Green Globe Award.
