### **SCOPE**

 Avoid duplication and integrate the groundwater monitoring activities required by OAC rules with the site-wide RI/FS groundwater characterization. In order to facilitate integration and avoid duplication, the Ohio EPA will review and approve portions of CERCLA documents for purposes of demonstrating compliance with OAC rules and these Orders.

## **ESTABLISHING MILESTONES**

- Within 45 days from the effective date of these Orders, Respondent shall submit a plan to Ohio EPA for its Alternate Program.
- Once approved, no changes or modifications shall be made by the Respondent to the Alternate Program plan without written notification to and written approval of Ohio EPA.

• These Orders may be modified by the Director upon written notification to the Respondent.

# **FUNDING**

• No provision in this Order shall be interpreted to require obligation or payment of funds in violation of the Anti-Deficiency Act.

# **PENALTIES**

- No specific monetary penalties are contained in this Agreement.
- Nothing contained in these Orders shall prevent Ohio EPA from seeking legal or equitable relief to enforce the terms of these Orders or from taking other authroized administrative, legal or equitable action as deemed appropriate for noncompliance with these Orders.
