I am writing to urge the U.S. Food and Drug Administration to review and approve over-the-counter sale of Emergency Contraception.

*The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the American Nurses Association, and the American Medical Women's Association* have all petitioned the FDA to allow pharmacists to provide over-the-counter Emergency Contraception.

Emergency Contraception can dramatically decrease unintended pregnancy. Researchers report that Emergency Contraception could prevent more than half of the nearly three million unintended pregnancies that occur in the U.S. each year.

By allowing the safe, affordable over-the-counter sale of Emergency Contraception, the Food and Drug Administration can help meet the health needs of millions of women and help resolve our planet's skyrocketing overpopulation crisis.
