

Captain Timothy P. Crowley, USCGR



Captain Timothy P. Crowley assumed his current duties as the Deputy Chief of Staff/Senior Reserve Officer for the Ninth Coast Guard District in July 2007. Prior to reporting to Cleveland, he served as the Senior Reserve Officer at U.S. Coast Guard Sector New York, the largest operational command in the Coast Guard, where he managed more than 400 reservists.

A native of New York City, Captain Crowley graduated from the United States Merchant Marine Academy at Kings Point in 1980. He served on active duty from 1980-1990 as a Marine Inspector/Marine Investigator at both the Marine Inspection Office New York and the Marine Safety Office Philadelphia. Since the events of September 11, he has been called to active duty on numerous occasions, serving in a variety of diverse roles, including Coast Guard Liaison to the Mayor of New York City immediately after 9/11; the Coast Guard Liaison to the Department of Defense's National Military Command Center (NMCC) during Operations Enduring Freedom and Noble Eagle; the J-5 Liaison to the NMCC leading up to Operation Iraqi Freedom; and most recently as the Senior Coast Guard Liaison to the newly-established Domestic Nuclear Detection Office in the Department of Homeland Security.

In his civilian profession, Captain Crowley serves as a Deputy Attorney General and General Counsel to the New Jersey Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness, the New Jersey Domestic Security Preparedness Task Force and the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management. He also acts as a Senior Policy Advisor to the Attorney General and Director of the Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness on homeland security issues. Prior to his tenure at the Attorney General's Office, he was a federal prosecutor with the U.S. Department of Justice, Antitrust Division and was in private practice with an admiralty law firm in Philadelphia.

Captain Crowley holds a Bachelor of Science in Nautical Science and a Juris Doctorate degree from the Rutgers University School of Law. He is also a graduate of the US Department of Justice Criminal Trial Advocacy and White Collar Criminal Prosecutions Course and the National

Institute of Trial Advocacy (NITA) Train the Trainer Course. He has also attended the Reserve Components National Security Course, the Joint & Interagency Security Course, Joint Forces Reserve Orientation Course and the Defense Support for Civil Authorities (DSCA) Executive Seminar and Regular DSCA Course. His military awards include the Coast Commendation Award (2), the Coast Guard Achievement Medal (2), the 9-11 Medal and the Commandant's Letter of Commendation.
