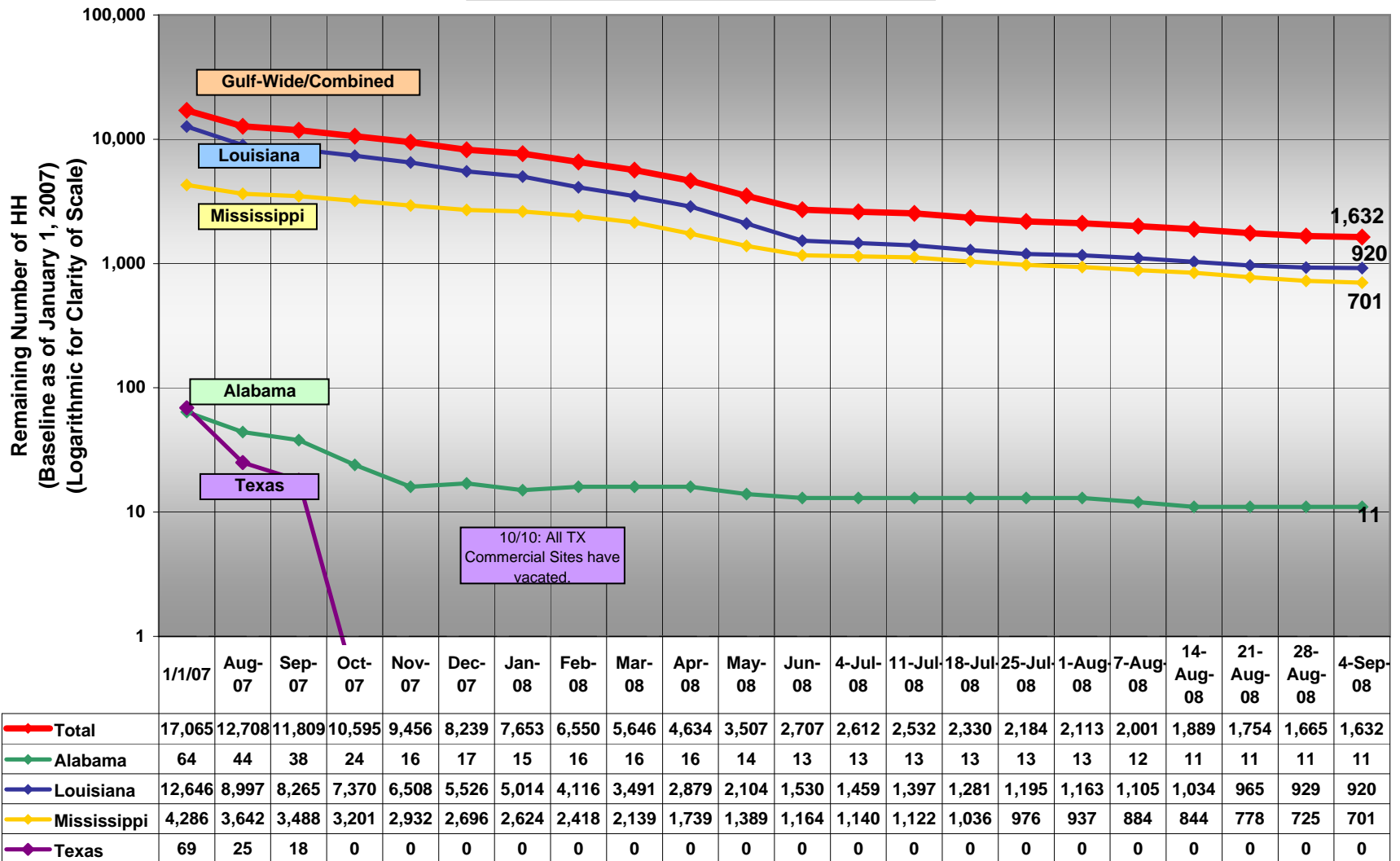

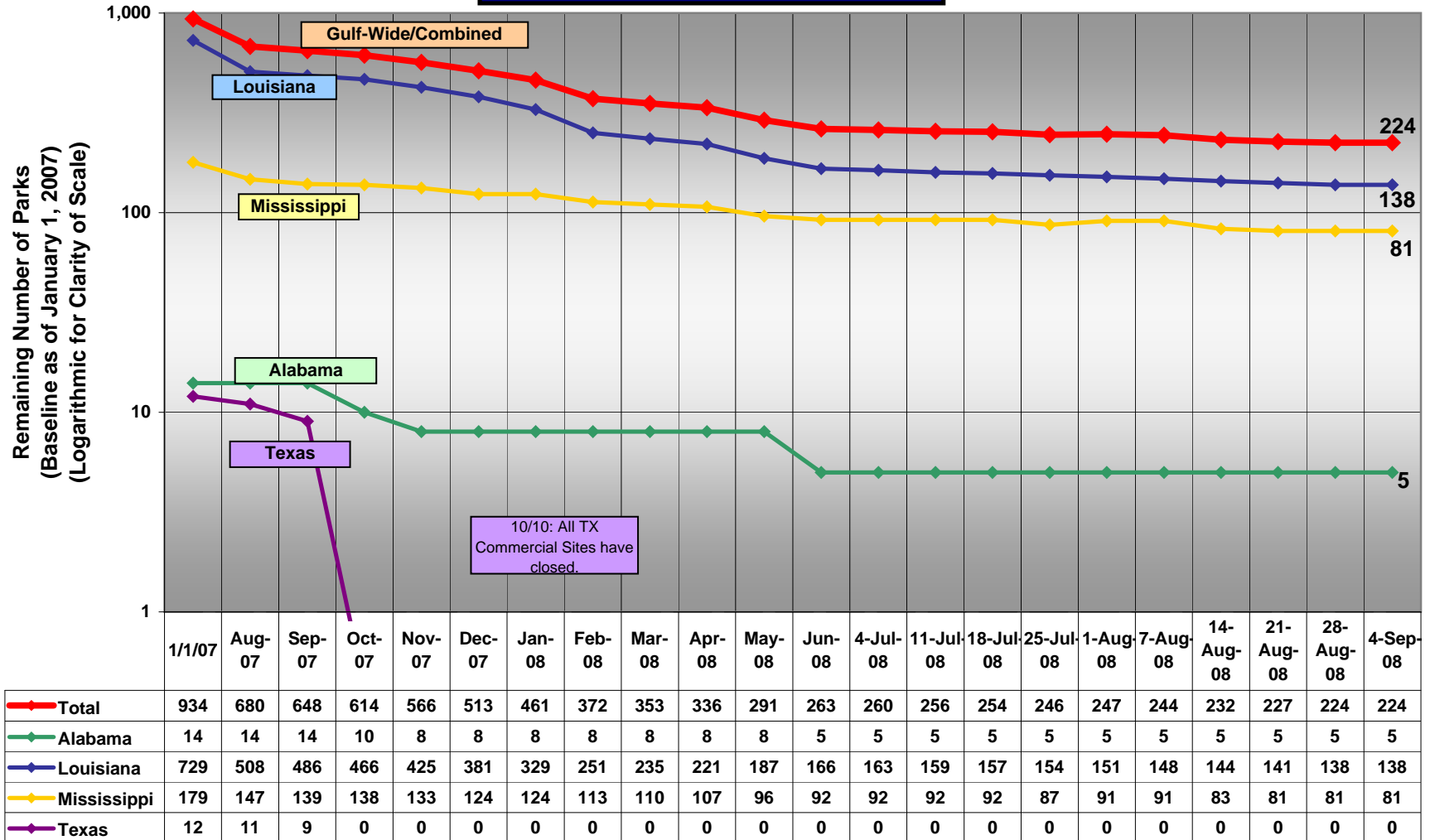

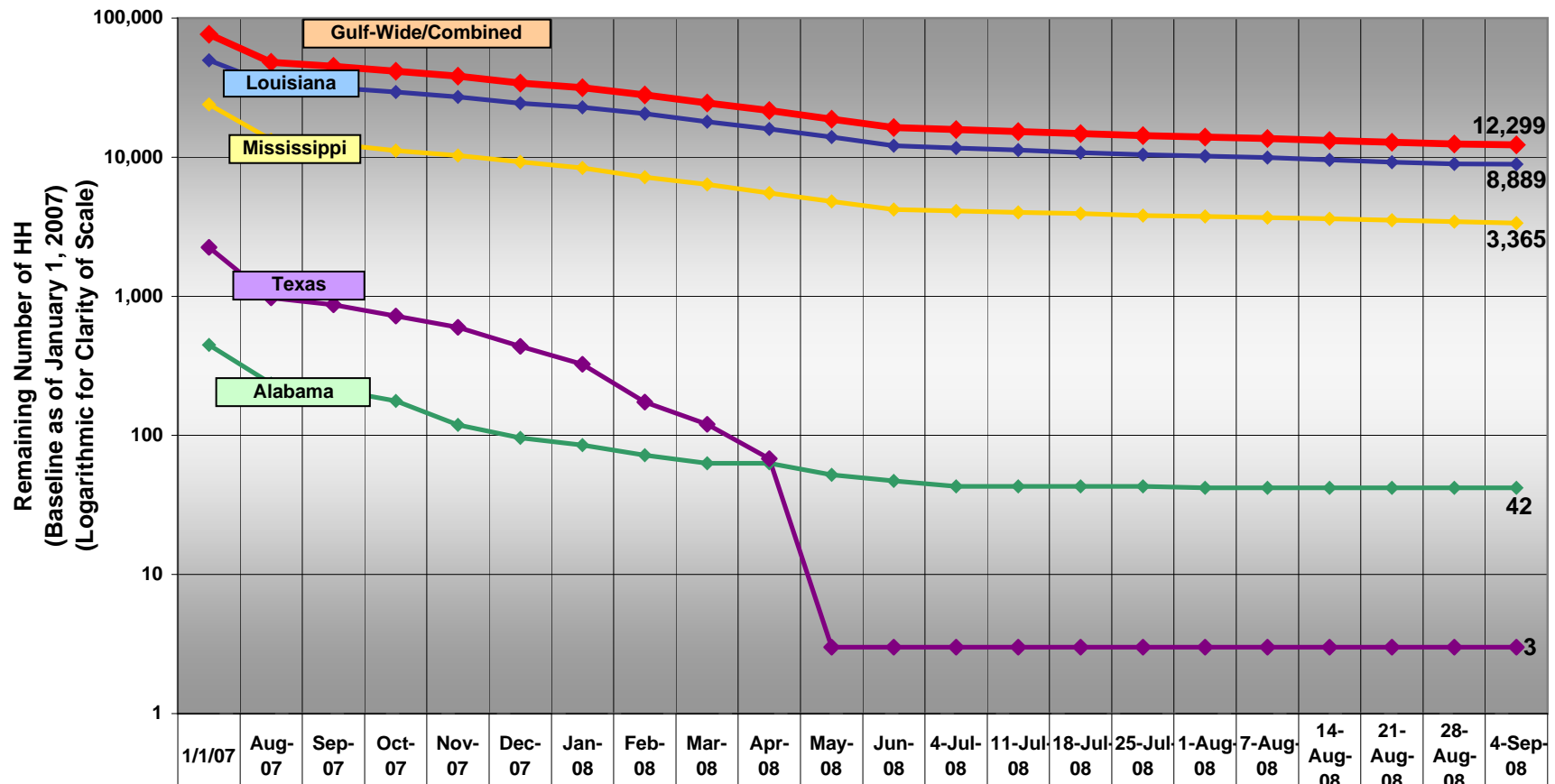
## Gulf-Wide Households (HH) by State (Commercial and Group Sites Only)
