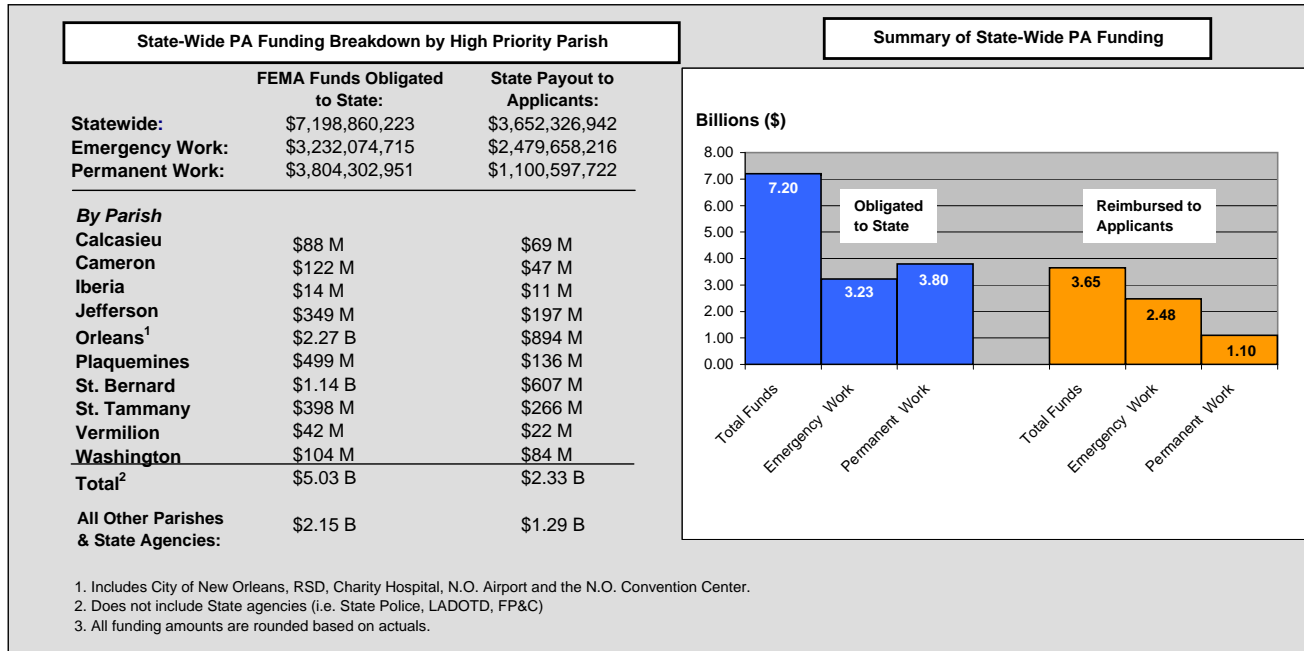

Continued Support of Louisiana Recovery FEMA Public Assistance Weekly Update

- Nearly \$2 million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to City of New Orleans towards public works. Work included removal and replacement of utility poles, chain link fences, gates, sidewalks, pedestrian bridges and asphalt bike trails.
- Over \$1.1 million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Housing Authority of New Orleans. Funds are for the demolition and rebuild of buildings to pre-disaster condition.
- Over \$1.1 million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to Port of New Orleans for the removal and replacement of parking lot and railroad ties, repair and replacement of underground utilities and roadway repair.
