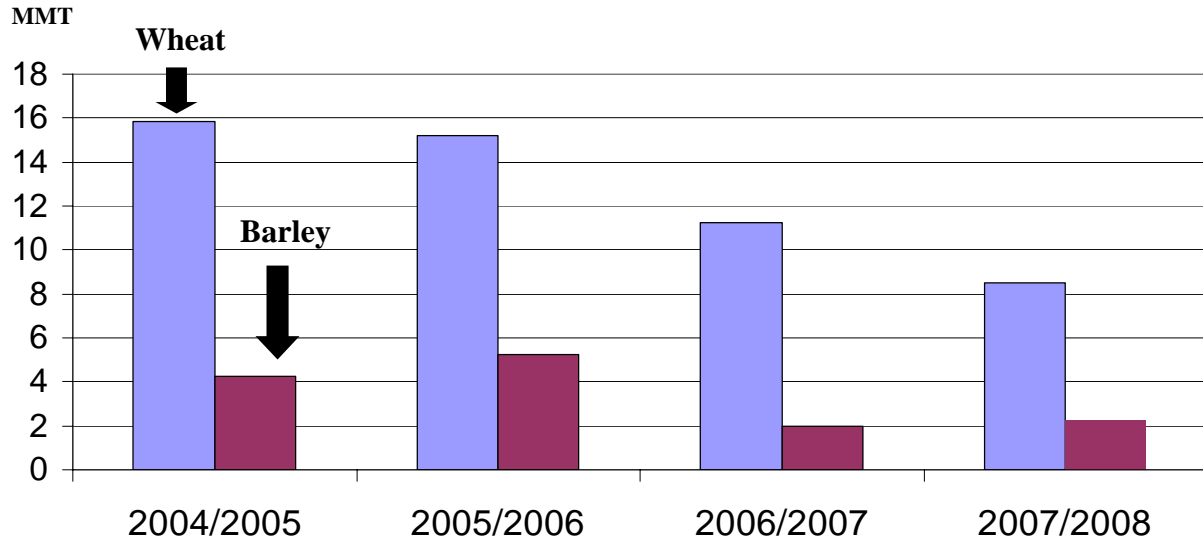


Grain: World Markets and Trade

Australian Wheat Exports Plummet



Australian wheat exports are expected to fall precipitously 4.5 million tons from last year to the lowest level in 13 years due to poor production resulting from drought. Because of low exportable supplies, Australia will undoubtedly focus its attention on major importers. It will try to maintain a strong presence in Japan, South Korea, Indonesia, and Malaysia, as well as attempt to recapture the Iraqi market. Nonetheless, it will not be able to satisfy demand for many traditional buyers in Asia, the Middle East, and the Mediterranean. Major grain suppliers such as the United States, Russia, and Kazakhstan will have the opportunity to increase their market shares in these regions.

Other grain exports are expected to be low as well. Barley is projected to remain at a low level for the second year in a row at 2.3 million tons. Sorghum and oats are to drop to 13-year lows because of strong demand from the domestic feed industry. Rice is estimated to plunge to a 46-year low to 40,000 tons.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. It is available on the FAS website (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/psdonline/>). This circular is released at 9:30 a.m. on the same day, together with its downloadable data set.

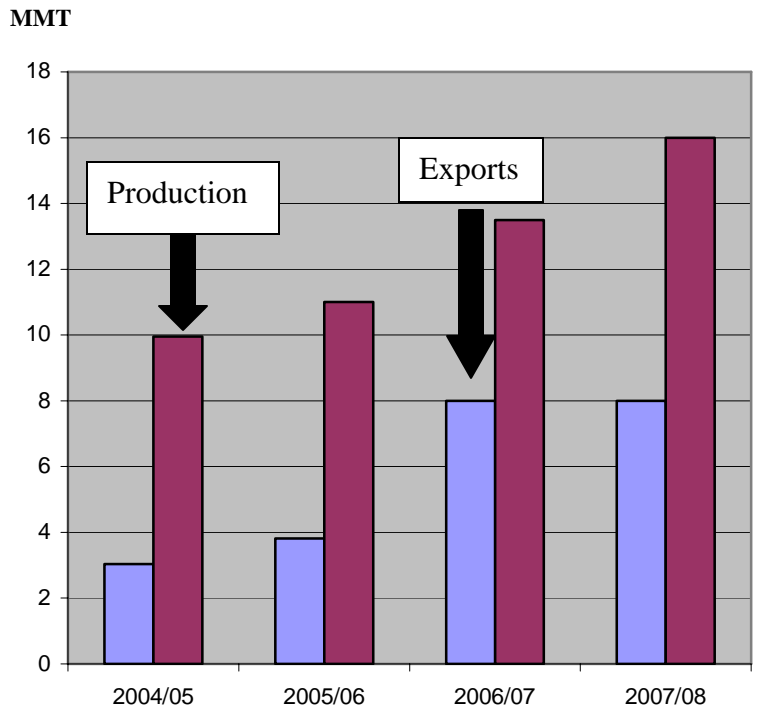
WHEAT: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:

Central Asian Supplier Takes Center Stage:

Kazakhstan's presence as a major supplier has become a crucial factor in world trade. With higher exportable supplies in 2007/08, it is expected to export 8 million tons. This will adequately satisfy the needs of its neighboring countries, which have been experiencing rising bread prices. Kazakhstan also will become an important player in the tight global wheat market by picking up slack from Ukraine and EU-27. Although landlocked, it still has a competitive advantage in delivering wheat to some major importers (e.g. Egypt, EU-27, Tunisia, and Yemen) due to access to Black Sea ports. This does not necessarily shut the door to more expensive U.S. exports, especially to those buyers that have stricter quality standards.

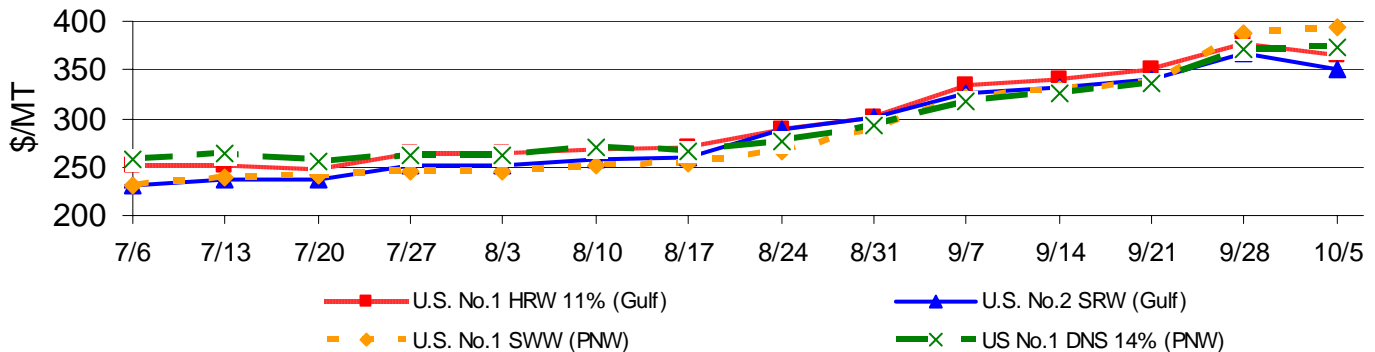
Kazakhstan Exports Strong on Higher Production



PRICES:

Domestic: For September, wheat prices for all classes surged on strong export sales, continued surging global import demand, and deteriorating crop conditions in Australia. For the month, Hard Red Winter (HRW) rose \$43 per ton, Hard Red Spring (HRS) rose \$54, Soft Red Winter (SRW) rose \$40, and Soft White (SWW) rose \$66.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2007/2008

Selected Exporters

- **Australia** is down 4.5 million tons to 8.5 million on devastating weather that has reduced production estimates.
- **Argentina** is up 500,000 tons to 10.0 million on improved crop prospects.
- **China** is up 500,000 tons to 3.0 million on expected strong sales to neighboring countries.
- **EU-27** is down 500,000 tons to 10.0 million reflecting lower production.
- **Kazakhstan** is up 1.5 million tons to 8.0 million on estimated higher production.
- **United States** is up 1.5 million tons to 31.5 million on stronger global import demand and less competition from some major suppliers, particularly Australia.

Selected Importers

- **Nigeria** is down 300,000 tons to 3.0 million on expected smaller purchases due to high prices.
- **Pakistan** is up 350,000 tons to 500,000 on a Government of Pakistan announcement of subsequent tenders in the next few months.
- **Turkey** is up 300,000 tons to 1.5 million due to a poor crop.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2006/2007

Selected Exporters

- **Australia** is down 3,000 tons to 11.241 million based on final trade numbers.
- **Kazakhstan** is up 2.0 million tons to 8.0 million based on final trade numbers.
- **Russia** is up 90,000 tons to 10.790 million based on final trade numbers.

Selected Importers

- **Egypt** is up 500,000 tons to 7.3 million due to large purchases from Syria.
- **Turkey** is up 333,000 tons to 1.8 million on strong late-season imports from Russia and Kazakhstan.
- **Tajikistan** is up 400,000 tons to 900,000 with late-season purchases from Kazakhstan.
- **Uzbekistan** is up 450,000 tons to 1.1 million with late-season purchases from Kazakhstan.

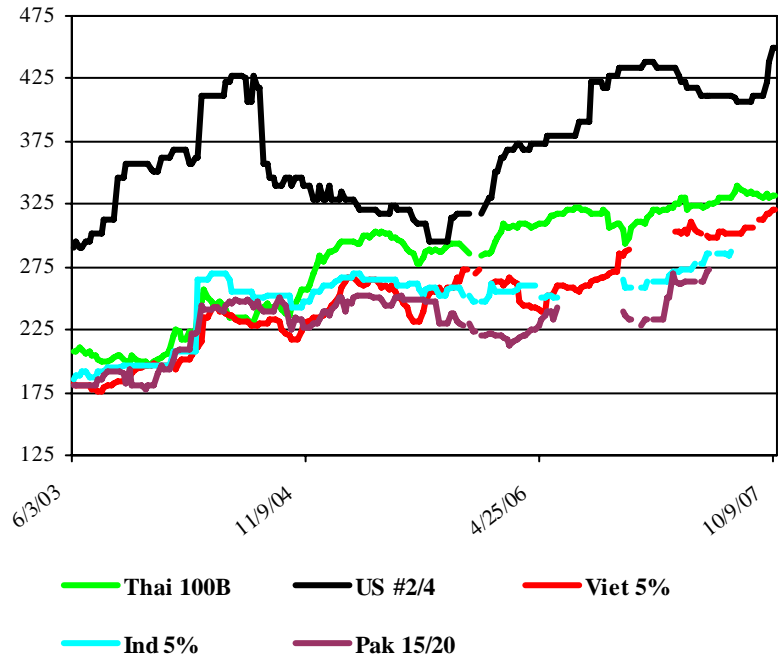
RICE: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES:

International: Thai quotes are largely steady, up \$2 from last month to \$332 per ton, FOB. Nominal quotes out of Vietnam are at \$320 per ton, FOB.

Domestic: U.S. #2/4 long grain milled rice quotes are up from last month to \$456 per ton, FOB. The spread between comparable qualities of Thai and U.S. rice is \$124 per ton compared to \$120 per ton this time last year. California medium grain #1/4 prices are up from last month at \$560 per ton, FOB.

TRADE CHANGES FOR 2008

Selected Exporters

- **China** is up 100,000 to 1.6 million tons in expectation that strong world prices and greater demand will draw more supplies out on world markets.
- **United States** is raised 200,000 to 3.3 million tons in anticipation of greater demand from major trading partners.

Selected Importers

- **Australia** is raised 125,000 to a record 275,000 tons based on tight supplies and expectations of an extremely small harvest.

TRADE CHANGES FOR 2007

Selected Exporters

- **India** is down 300,000 to 4.2 million tons due to the announced export ban.
- **Thailand** is down 100,000 tons to 8.5 million tons due to logistical constraints at major shipping points.

- **Vietnam** is down 100,000 tons to 4.6 million tons due to tight supplies and an export ban.

Selected Importers

- **China** is down 100,000 to 600,000 tons as result of a slow import pace.
- **Cuba** is down 100,000 tons to 600,000 tons based on pace to date.
- **Iraq** is down 100,000 to 800,000 tons because of slow buying in the first half of the year.

COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:

Coarse Grain Trade Hits Another Record: Global coarse grain trade for 2007/08 has been raised by over 2 million tons this month to a record 117 million. Improved prospects for the U.S. crop, diminished competition, and tight global supplies have boosted corn trade by nearly 9 million tons since the initial corn export forecast for 2007/08 was released in May 2007. This month U.S. exports are projected up 2 million tons at a record 92 million.

PRICES:

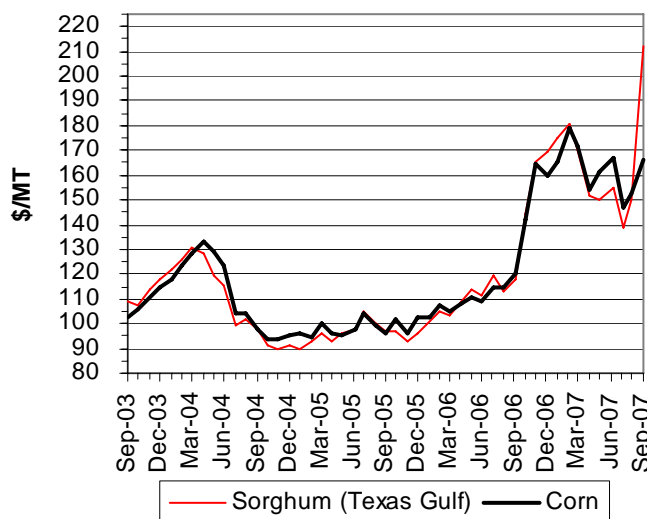
Domestic: U.S average corn prices in September were \$166 per ton, up over \$10 from August prices while sorghum prices soared to \$212 per ton due to strong demand from Europe. Early season U.S. sorghum commitments have again reached an unprecedented level of 4.1 million tons, nearly five times larger than the same time last year. “Unknown” sales of over 2.2 million tons are expected to be largely for shipment to the EU-27.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2007/2008

Selected Exporters

- **United States corn** is up 3.0 million tons to 60.0 million, tied for second-highest ever with 1989/90. Corn is attractively priced relative to other feed grains, including feed quality wheat, and export competition remains weak.
- **Brazil corn** is boosted 500,000 tons to a record 8.5 million owing to large sales to the EU-27. (It is also raised a like amount to 8.0 million tons for 2006/07.)
- **China corn** is cut in half to 1.5 million tons, the smallest in over a decade, because of reduced production prospects in the face of firm internal feed grain demand. (The previous year is raised by 400,000 tons to 5.2 million based on new trade data.)
- **Australia barley** is slashed 2.2 million tons to 2.3 million due to a cut in production. **Oats** are cut 100,000 tons to 75,000 because of limited domestic feed grain supplies.
- **Canada barley** is up 400,000 tons to 2.4 million, the highest in over a decade, due to reduced competition.

U.S. Gulf Export Bids



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- **EU-27 barley** is up 500,000 tons to 4.0 million, the highest in 6 years, because of North African demand and diminishing Australian exportable supplies.
 - **Kazakhstan barley** is boosted 400,000 tons to 1.0 million, the highest in over 15 years, because of large exportable supplies and strong regional demand.
 - **United States sorghum** is raised by 1.0 million tons to 6.6 million, the highest in 15 years, due to strong demand from the EU-27 for supplies of GMO-free feed.

Selected Importers

- **Brazil corn** is raised by 450,000 tons to 750,000 (2006/07 trade is boosted 200,000 tons to 1.05 million) because of robust exports that are partly supplied by imports of Paraguayan corn.
- **Canada corn** is boosted by 300,000 tons to 2.0 million because of its competitiveness against other feed grains, which have attractive international prices.
- **EU-27 corn** is up 1.5 million tons to a record 9.5 million because of tight supplies of feed grains (imports for 2006/07 are raised the same amount to 7.1 million). Production prospects for all grains are reduced by over 2 million tons this month and imports of corn from Brazil (and U.S. sorghum) are filling the deficit.
- **China barley** is down 400,000 tons to 1.4 million on a tight international supply picture and production cuts in Australia.
- **Saudi Arabia barley** is down 200,000 tons to 5.8 million because of overall market tightness.
- **EU-27 sorghum** soars by 1.5 million tons to a record 3.0 million. Import licenses and outstanding purchases of U.S. sorghum reflect the shortage of feed grains.
- **Mexico sorghum** is cut by 500,000 tons to 2.5 million due to availability of U.S. corn and relatively high export prices for sorghum.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2006/2007

Selected Exporters

- **Argentina corn** is up 700,000 tons to 15.0 million as shipments continue at a record pace.
- **Paraguay corn** is raised 300,000 tons to 1.8 million based on expanded trade with Brazil. (Brazil imports are raised a like amount to 850,000 tons.)

Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in marketing year imports and marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA

database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
