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## Sprouts Changing to PALS

Beginning with this issue, you will notice a big change in the appearance of the *Sprouts* Newsletter.

Sprouts is being replaced with the Planning, Appeals, and Litigation System (PALS), a nationwide, webbased, database application that captures key planning information for internal and external use. It is the Agency's first web-based application of its kind. We look forward to the benefits PALS will bring to the Forest Service and the public. PALS currently automates production of the quarterly Schedule of Proposed Actions (SOPA) (FSH 1909.15, 07) and facilitates biannual reporting of **Cooperating Agency** information to the Council on **Environmental Quality** (CEQ). PALS will also improve our ability to respond to internal and external data requests.

All National Forests will use PALS for tracking/reporting of projects whose decisions are expected to be documented in a Decision Memo, Decision Notice, or Record of Decision under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

We are now updating our mailing list for those wishing to receive a quarterly printed PALS reports. Comments received in response to this solicitation, including names and addresses of those who comment on these projects, will be considered part of the public record and will be available for public inspection. Comments submitted anonymously will be accepted and considered; however, those who submit anonymous comments will not have standing to appeal the subsequent decision under 36 CFR Parts 215. Additionally, pursuant to 7 CFR 1.27 (d), any person may request the agency to withhold a submission from the public record by showing how the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) permits such confidentiality.

Persons requesting such confidentiality should be aware that, under the FOIA, confidentiality may be granted in only very limited circumstances, such as to protect trade secrets. The Forest Service will inform the requester of the agency's decision regarding the request for confidentiality, and where the request is denied, the agency will return the submission and notify the requester that the comments may be resubmitted with or without name and address within a specified timeframe.
