Waiver request of in-vivo testing: 125 mg/31.25 mg, based on (i) acceptable bioequivalence studies on the 250 mg/62.5 mg strength, (ii) formulation proportionality across all strengths, and (iii) acceptable in vitro dissolution testing of all strengths.
