FOREIGN NATIONALS (12-99)

- (a) Part or all of the work under this subcontract will be performed at a DOE facility. DOE Notice 142.1 requires prior approval for the performance of work at, and visits to, DOE facilities by "foreign nationals."
- (b) The Notice defines a "foreign national" as any person (including a permanent resident alien) who is not a U.S. citizen.
- (c) Offerors (or the Seller under a resulting subcontract) must provide to the Company's subcontract administrator the following information concerning each foreign national for whom approval to visit or work onsite is requested: (1) name, (2) date and place of birth, (3) address, (4) country of citizenship, (5) name and address of current employer, (6) title, position, or description of duties, (7) passport number, (8) passport expiration date; and (9) U.S. visa number, if any. The Company should receive the information no less than 90 days prior to the anticipated visit or the beginning of work onsite.
- (d) Requests for approval of a visit or onsite work by a foreign national may be denied. Denial will not constitute grounds for an equitable adjustment or constitute an excusable delay under the subcontract.
