

NOTICE OF TOTAL SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE (Jan 2005)

(a) Definition. "Small business concern," as used in this Notice, means a concern, including its affiliates, that is independently owned and operated, not dominant in the field of operation in which it is bidding on Government contracts, and qualified as a small business under the size standard in paragraph (b) below.

(b) Size Standard. The offeror is deemed to be a small business when (checked block applies):

its "number of employees," as defined in 13 CFR 121.106, does not exceed ____ persons.

its "annual receipts," as defined in 13 CFR 121.104, do not exceed \$_____.
