Re: Steel Import Monitoring and Analysis System

## Dear Director Parkhill:

We are writing on behalf of the Arcelor Group ("Arcelor") in response to the Department of Commerce's ("the Department's") request for comments on the Steel Import Monitoring and Analysis ("SIMA") system.<sup>1</sup> Arcelor is concerned that the existing system does not adequately protect trade data and, as such, is an impediment to international commerce.

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The Department has an affirmative obligation to protect trade secrets. Among the most

valuable trade secrets are those dealing with marketing strategy, price, and sales volume.

Although the aggregation of import data extracted from multiple sources offers some protection

from the threat presented by public release of entered value and volume data, the Department

must exercise extreme caution to ensure that no harm is done.

In the steel industry, reporting data on particular HTSUS numbers can, under certain

circumstances, harm both exporters and importers. For example, it is often known that only one

manufacturer in a given country is capable of manufacturing specific products defined by HTS

item numbers. Release of any pricing or volume data with respect to imports under such a

situation can harm the exporters and importers of the product, and amounts to the release of

protected trade data.

Accordingly, we ask that the Department take whatever measures are necessary to ensure

that any public release of information does not improperly provide proprietary competitive data

to competitors.
