Angostura Resource Management Plan Proposed Alternatives

Terminology - (For the purpose of this Resource Management Plan)

Management Unit (MU) - Described as geographic areas, within the overall study area, that can be effectively managed as a relatively independent area.

Goal - A goal is a brief statement describing a desired condition that Reclamation or SDGFP wishes to achieve within a management unit. Goals may be short term or long term.

Objective - A statement or series of statements that briefly describe an action that could be one of many steps in achieving a management unit goal. Specific management actions are developed from RMP objectives.

Proposed Management Action - Can also be referred to as opportunities and is defined as an action or group of actions which are developed to provide solutions to the issues raised externally by the public and internally by Reclamation or SDGFP staff. Proposed management actions should enhance, protect, and interpret the resources of a particular management unit as well as to provide for a wide variety of recreation facilities and opportunities. Each proposed management action must be realistic and within anticipated funding and staffing levels. The end result of each proposed management action must meet the objectives and specific goal for its respective management unit.

Proposed Alternatives

Alternative A – No Action Under the No Action Alternative, management of the Recreation Area would continue as outlined in existing agreements, current laws, new or amended regulations, and policy. The 1992 Master Plan would serve as the blueprint for management of the area. In addition to the Master Plan, improvements would be made on an "as needed" basis, or if needed to meet health, safety, American's with Disabilities Act or other legal requirements.

Alternative B – Developed Recreation Under this alternative a variety of improvements would be made to visitor use facilities, recreational areas, and resources areas. This alternative would allow for a balance between natural resource protection, developed recreation and dispersed recreation. It would limit degradation of natural and cultural resource while developing diverse recreation opportunities consistent with the Management Unit Goals

Alternative C – Enhanced Recreation This alternative would include all of the proposed actions from Alternative B plus additional recreational developments which provide for an increase in the overall development in MU's 2 4, 5, 9, 10, 12, and 19.

Proposed Management Actions Considered but Eliminated - The actions in this category were not considered feasible at this time. The reason for these determinations will be explained in the Environmental Assessment.
