Colson and three other GRS HQ personnel visited a four-classroom rural elementary school in Muthanna Province July 27. Hilal Al Bajari School Headmaster Salem Jaheel said, "The gifts mean a lot to our students. This is a special day. You have made them very happy." He said he is working with the Muthanna Provincial Reconstruction Team to get funding to expand his school that currently has more than 100 students attending grades 1-6. The headmaster has a personal investment there as he used his own funds to build the facility four years ago. "We need at least two additional classrooms," he added.
