Dear Public Health Provider,

This letter is to notify you that all lots of Dryvax® smallpox vaccine will expire on February 29, 2008 and should no longer be used after that date.

After this date, you must immediately cease using any Dryvax® and destroy the product on site. Please use this letter (see below) to provide written documentation of this destruction to the CDC Drug Service. Disposal of the vaccine must be carried out within 30 days of the expiration date (February 29, 2008) in accordance with the current CDC Policy on Unused Smallpox Vaccine, found at: http://www.bt.cdc.gov/agent/smallpox/vaccination/unusedvaccinepolicy.asp
