



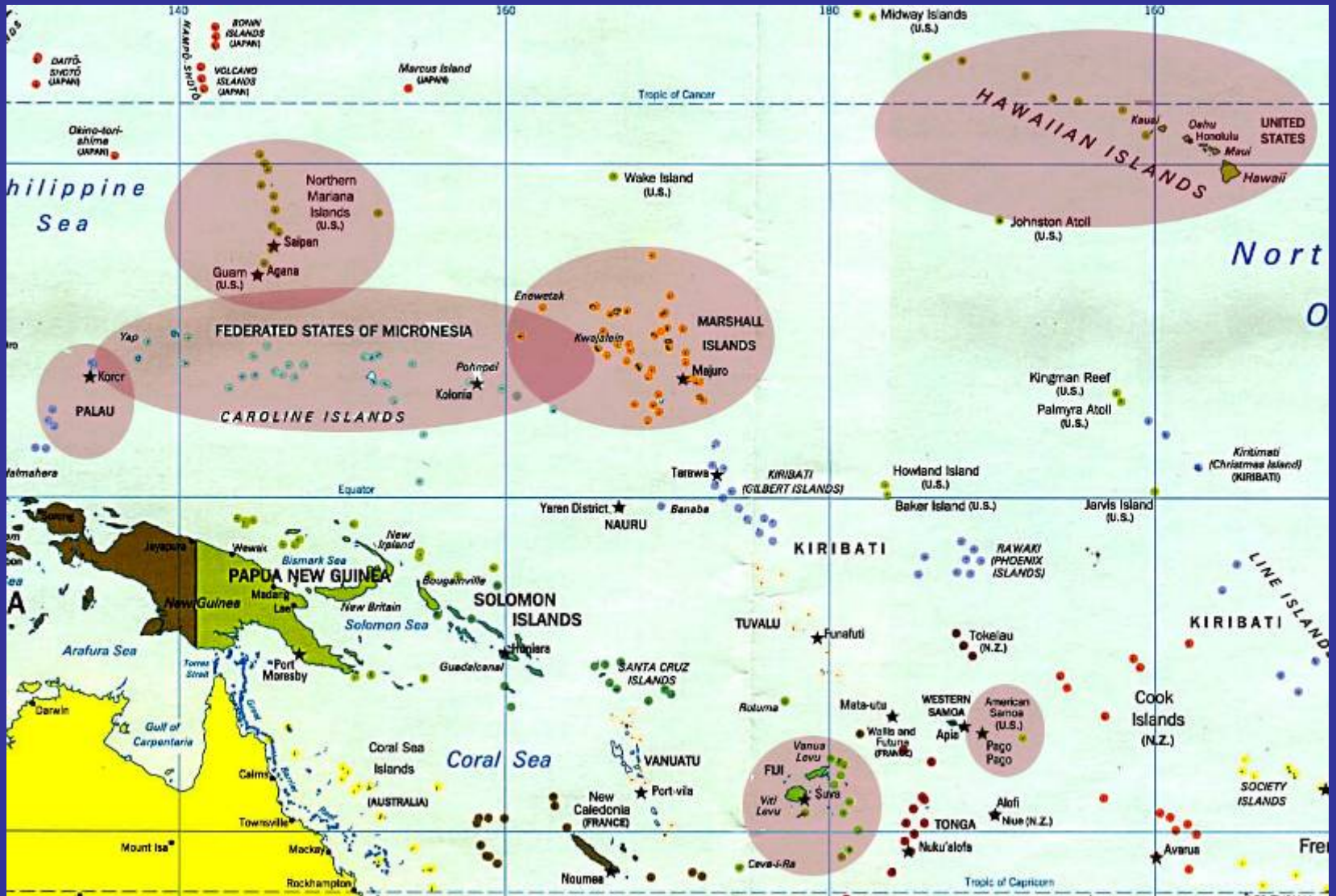

a continuous community for the sharing of information, expertise, and experience to build MPA capacity

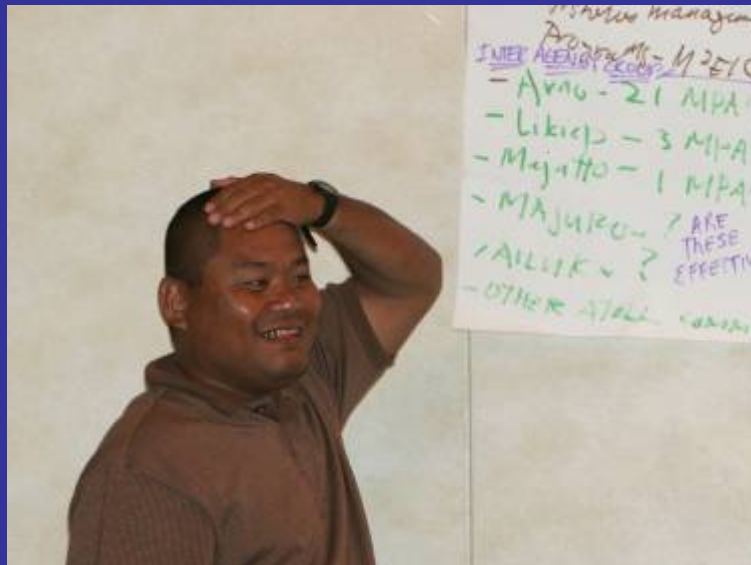


Challenges PIMPAC will Address
