MARINE TANK VESSEL OPERATIONS

NOTIFICATION FOR LIGHTERING, BALLASTING, OR TANK CLEANING AWAY FROM MARINE TERMINALS (Section 404)

The owner or operator of a marine tank vessel conducting **lightering**, **ballasting**, or **cleaning of tanks** that <u>contain a regulated organic liquid</u>, or had a prior cargo of a regulated organic liquid must **provide written notice to the District 24 hours <u>prior</u>** to beginning the operation. The notification must include the following information:

 indicate if it has any existing BAAQMD site number. Identify the specific project location, and event
 description of why compliance with this rule would either (1) be a violation of any regulation or other
 requirement of the United States Coast Guard, or (2) would prevent an act or omission that is
 necessary to secure the safety of a vessel or for saving life at sea.
- NOTIFICATION FOR LIGHTERING, BALLASTING, OR TANK CLEANING: The owner or operator of a marine tank vessel must provide written notice to the District 24 hours <u>prior</u> to beginning lightering, ballasting, or cleaning of tanks that contain a regulated organic liquid, or had a prior cargo of a regulated organic liquid. Complete the site and description information required above.
