Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishery Update

Below are preliminary landings estimates in metric tons (mt) and pounds (lb) dressed weight (dw) for the Atlantic shark commercial fisheries for the 2nd and 3rd trimester seasons of 2005. These landings estimates include landing reports received as of November 8, 2005. Any state landings and overharvests from this season will be totaled and counted against future quotas, as appropriate. Any over- or underharvests from the 2nd trimester season in a region will be carried over to the 2006 2nd trimester season for the same region, and any over- or underharvests from the 3rd trimester season in a region will be carried over to the 2006 3rd trimester season for the same region.
