DRAFT MINUTES

Summary of Board of Directors Executive Committee Meeting Immediately Following Budget & Finance Committee Meeting Monday, March 26, 2007

- 1. Call to Order Roll Call: Chair Mark Ross called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m.
 - **Present:** Mark Ross, Chair, Chris Daly, Scott Haggerty, Jerry Hill, Patrick Kwok, Tim Smith, Pamela Torliatt.
 - Absent: Gayle B. Uilkema, Brad Wagenknecht.

Also Present: Michael Shimansky.

- 2. **Public Comment Period**: There were no public comments.
- **3. Approval of Minutes of February 9, 2007**: Director Hill moved approval of the minutes; seconded by Director Smith; carried unanimously without objection.
- **4. Presentation by Rachel Morello-Frosch:** *Rachael Morello-Frosch of Brown University made a presentation regarding a report she co-authored entitled "Still Toxic After All These Years Air Quality and Environmental Justice in the San Francisco Bay Area." This is an informational item.*

Dr. Rachel Morello-Frosch discussed the report and reviewed the following:

- The motivation for the Study.
- Cumulative impact and community vulnerability to toxics.
- The findings and assembling the data for the project.
- Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) facilities relative to neighborhood demographics and how the TRI proximity is determined.
- Population by race/ethnicity (2000) and proximity to a TRI facility with air releases (2003) in the 9-county Bay Area.
- The disparate pattern is a result of land use perspective, income, and regional politics.
- Ambient air toxics, which come from a diverse array of sources and can create "hot spots."
- Estimating cancer and respiratory risks associated with ambient air toxics exposures. Looking at the risk to see if there is a pattern.

Draft Minutes of March 26, 2007 Board Executive Committee Meeting

The Committee discussed several aspects of the report, including emissions at the Port of Oakland and the impact on the surrounding community, pollution from highway 880 and its transport into the Livermore valley, and that the District's Community Air Risk Evaluation (CARE) Program will conduct additional monitoring.

In conclusion, Dr. Morello-Frosch reviewed the four guiding principles: 1) considering cumulative impacts; 2) taking into account social vulnerability; 3) promote meaningful community participation, and 4) take meaningful action.
