#### **DRAFT MINUTES**

Summary of Board of Directors Personnel Committee Meeting 9:30 a.m., Friday, January 12, 2007

1. Call to Order: Chairperson Patrick Kwok called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

Roll Call: Patrick Kwok, Chairperson; Scott Haggerty, Yoriko Kishimoto, Carol

Klatt.

**Absent:** Harold Brown, Nate Miley, Michael Shimansky.

**Also Present:** Mark Ross.

**2. Public Comment Period:** There were none.

- **3. Approval of Minutes of December 4, 2006:** Director Klatt requested that the spelling of her name be corrected. Director Kishimoto noted she was not present at the last meeting and, therefore did not make the motion under Committee Action on page 2 of the minutes. The Clerk indicated Director Torliatt made the motion. Director Klatt moved approval of the minutes as corrected; seconded by Director Ross; carried unanimously without objection.
- 4. Discussion of Recommendations of Applicants to Fill Nine Positions on the Air District's Advisory Council: The Committee discussed recommendations of candidates to fill nine (9) positions that have expired terms of offices on the Advisory Council.

Jack Broadbent, Executive Officer/APCO, stated that at the December 4<sup>th</sup> meeting the Committee conducted interviews for positions on the Advisory Council. At the December 6, 2006 Board meeting, Chair Uilkema referred the matter back to the Committee for further discussion.

Brian Bunger, Counsel, added that there are 20 members of the Advisory Council and there are 19 categories. There are five members that are in the Conservation Organization, of which two are from the Sierra Club.

**Committee Action:** Director Klatt moved that the Committee reaffirm the motion made on December 4, 2006 regarding the appointments to the Advisory Council; seconded by Director Ross.

There was discussion on the following:

- The different categories and ways to realign members to the appropriate category.
- The Board has discretion on the Advisory Council and a Council member can be removed by a majority of the Board.
- Concern was raised about Article 9 in the Code.
- The term limit for Council members is 12 years.
- Director Haggerty requested staff look at the governing rules for the Advisory Council and Hearing Board for discussion and update at a future meeting.
- The amount of staff time spent on the Council activities.
- The role of the Council could be better defined.

The motion then passed unanimously without objection.

Re: Conduct Interviews of Candidates to Fill the Regular and Alternate Member

Positions for the Medical Profession and Registered Professional Engineer

Categories on the District's Hearing Board

### RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Conduct interviews and consider recommending Board of Director approval of appointments of candidates to fill the regular and alternate positions in the Medical Profession and Registered Professional Engineer categories on the District's Hearing Board.

#### BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Section 40800 of the California Health and Safety Code the District is required to maintain a Hearing Board consisting of five members. Further, Section 40801 requires that one of the members is a professional engineer registered as such pursuant to the Professional Engineers Act (Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 6700) of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code) and one of the members is from the medical profession with specialized skills, training, or interests in the field of environmental medicine, community medicine, or occupational/toxicological medicine. Section 40800 also allows the District to appoint one alternate member for each of the position categories, provided that the alternate has the qualifications specified in Section 40801.

## **DISCUSSION**

The Hearing Board currently has four vacancies: one regular and one alternate Registered Professional Engineer position, and one regular and one alternate Medical Profession position. There are eleven candidates who submitted applications. Two of the eleven candidates were determined to not possess the required qualifications. Of the remaining nine candidates, there are five candidates for the regular and alternate Registered Professional Engineer positions and four candidates for the Medical Profession positions. All candidates will be interviewed on March 5, 2007. The interviews will begin at 9:40 am. The length of each interview will be approximately fifteen minutes.
