Comments: The option for net metering should not be given to the distributers instead of consumers; growth in availability of green power will be impeded and many consumers who live in TVA service areas for which the electric coop opts out (such as mine has) will be blocked from participating in generation partnering.

Additionally, the purchase price for residential-generated green power should not be lowered until the equipment and installation costs drop much more significantly. Without some financial help, the cost is still prohibitive for residential installations and it is more likely to stay that way if this significant cost recovery incentive is eliminated. In time as more people have solar power installed, start-up costs will come down and financial incentives won't be such a critical factor.
